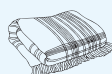

# Workshop on Business Etiquette and Effective Communication

## Safe Motherhood- Right Not Need



**K**KF started a project named '**Safe Motherhood- Right not Need**' to train the midwives of the remotest village in Bangladesh. To contribute more in SDG 3 (Good Health and Well Being) KKF takes the initiative to start this project at Erendabari, Gaibandha District. The selected villages are the remotest chars of Fulchari Union.

By completing this six months training foundation believes, these skilled midwives will play a significant role to reduce mother mortality, pre and post natal crisis in chars like erendabari.

## Eid Food Distribution among the Distressed People

On the occasion of Eid ul Fitr KKF distributed improved lunch among **470** distressed people in different parts of Dhaka city.



## Emergency Flood Relief

As the Surma and the Kushiara keep rising, more and more areas of Sylhet and Sunamganj are going underwater every day and large number of flood victims suffering from scarcity of food and drinking water. As per the dailies around 20 lakh people have been affected by the flash floods in the two districts.

In a joint venture with Give Bangladesh, KKF started its first phase campaign "Fight against Flood" and distributed relief among **300 families** on May 23, 2022. The team covered Syedabad, Latargaon, Rabardam, Baishakandi, Mahishapur, Bahadurpur, Sinakandi, and Rahmatpur villages of Islampur union of Chhatak Upazila and Barbara Primary School, next to Mughalpara Mosque, Hadapandab Bazar.



Each relief package contained 7 kg flatrice, 1 kg molasses, 10 pieces' oral saline, 2 packets biscuits, and water purification tablets.



## Eid Meat - Distribution

For the last three years, KKF has been successfully taking this initiative of distributing 100% halal meat of Qurbani to needy and distressed families. On the occasion of Eid Ul Adha, KKF distributed Qurbani meat to **1000+ distressed people** in different parts of Dhaka city. Among these there are two orphanages which have more than 300 orphans. Apart from raw meats, foundation also provided other cooking materials like rice, potatoes, spices and oils.

## Eid Meal Distribution for Sunamgonj and Gaibandha Flood Victims

In joint collaboration with Give Bangladesh, Foundation also distributed cooked food in the villages of Mohishmara, Kuira, Jainagarnama of Nuwairiya Union Sunamganj and in Maltola, Chapadoho, Khourodo Malibari and Baguria Villages villages of Kuptola, Lakhipur and Baguria Union, Gaibandha. More than **2000 cooked meals** were distributed among the flood victims on the first two days of Eid ul Adha.

## Relief Activities at Chaatak



In the fourth phase of “Fight against Flood” foundation distributed rations to **300 families** of five villages (Bhugli, Borchal, Banarasipur, Binodpur, Koholla) of Choila Afzalabad Union, Chhatak Upazila on 5th July. The package included (6 kg Rice, 2 kg potatoes, 1 kg lentil, 0.5 kg salt, 0.5 kg toast, 5 Pieces Saline, 1 pack liquefied milk, 1 pack juice & Water Purification Tablet).

## Dental Camp 2022



Foundation in collaboration with Rashid Foundation and Rotary Club arranged a Dental Camp for Joy Shokol Shishur Children on 3 July 2022. **72 children** and **8 staff** received services from the camp. At the end of the camp, children received gifts from the organizer. The program was held at KK Foundation’s program office.

## Sunamganj - Medical Camp

Following the relief effort under the campaign "Fight against Flood"s in flood-hit areas of Sunamganj, foundation organized a medical camp as a part of the post-flood response in Char Mahalla Union, Chaatak, Sunamganj on 22nd July 2022.

Foundation ensured the treatment of **500 people**, including 150 children. As per the suggestion and prescriptions by the doctors, the medicines were explained and given to the beneficiaries. Five doctors and a volunteer team conducted the day-long camp in Ballavpur village of Char Moholla Sunamganj.



## Bandarban - Medical Camp

Chittagong Hill Tracts is witnessing a rapid increase in Malaria cases in last few months and this year the intensity is higher than the previous years. Foundation conducted two medical camps in two villages of Bandarban named Andermanik and Likri on 10th-11th August. Four doctors and twelve volunteers were involved in the medical camps and more than four hundred people received the medical facilities along with medicines from the camp.
